COOKIE POLICY

1 Information about the use of our cookies

- 1.1 A cookie is a small piece of data, usually a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer (if you consent to us using cookies). Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.
- 1.2 Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our website.

2 Functional and required cookies

- 2.1 Our company website runs on **1&1 IONOS Ltd**. 1&1 IONOS Ltd uses some necessary cookies because they allow visitors to navigate and use key features on our site. The Functional and Required Cookies which are used on our site are:

Cookie	Duration	Purpose
Crumb	Session	Prevents cross-site request forgery (CSRF). CSRF is an attack vector that tricks a browser into taking unwanted action in an application when someone's logged in.

3 Analytics and performance cookies

- 3.1 We use Analytics and Performance cookies to collect information on your behalf about how visitors interact with your site. Storing these cookies is how we populate the data you find in our analytics, such as traffic sources, unique visitors, and cart abandonment.
- 3.2 You can delete the cookies at any time. The Analytics and Performance Cookies which are used on our site are:

Cookie	Duration	Purpose
Wordpress_*	1 year	Recognise you when you return to our site to add comments to blog articles.
__utm*	2 years	Collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.
wfwaf-authcookie-(hash)	Session	This cookie is used by the Wordfence firewall to perform a capability check of the current user before WordPress has been loaded.

wf_loginalerted_(hash)	Session	This cookie is used to notify the Wordfence admin when an administrator logs in from a new device or location.
wfCBLBypass	Session	Wordfence offers a feature for a site visitor to bypass country blocking by accessing a hidden URL. This cookie helps track who should be allowed to bypass country blocking.
